Plan the menu. Make a card with your menu on it. Include everything you will serve: e.g. main dish, side dishes, bread, dessert and beverage. Keep nutrition in mind.

Think of a centerpiece, table covering, color scheme/theme, place cards, dishes and the utensils

Bring your menu, 1-place setting, centerpiece and table covering on Monday, August 1st between 1 & 7 pm. Contestant must set up own entry. Each entry will be given a 3 foot x 3 foot area.

Entries will remain on display throughout the fair. Pick up your entry on Monday, August 8 from 8:30 am-noon.

Judging points given for originality, correct table setting, safety, attractiveness, and appropriateness for menu, color scheme & centerpiece. (We encourage creativity, but the judge should feel comfortable eating at your table as it is set and, on the plates, used.)

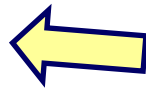

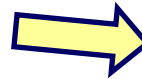

Everyone will receive a prize. Cash prizes for winners!

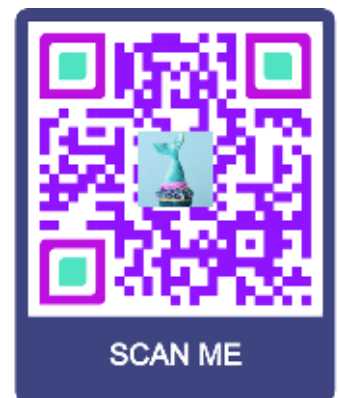
Special prizes: Bake something patriotic themed to match the fair theme

1. Animals are to be checked in from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, Aug. 4, 2022.
2. Owner agrees to be responsible for food and water for animal twice a day. Water is available onsite. Owner agrees to spend 2 hours managing the contest area during the fair (sign up). **Animals must be picked up on Sat. Aug. 6 at 7 p.m.**
3. Examples of small animals are chickens, pigeons, guinea pigs & rabbits. Entry must be able to fit comfortably in a 18x18x24 inch pen.
